Who we serve: To become a client individuals need to bring an ID, and piece of mail with their current address.

They also need to show proof of income once a year to qualify,

1. Families from Davie County, Davidson, Iredell, Rowan & Yadkinville: Working poor families, families without income, single parent families, families affected by illness, elderly; domestic violence families, homeless/transient families, etc.
2. Davie County residents without medical, dental, eye or drug insurance, or Medicaid, who are within 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
3. Churches, ministries, community agencies, schools, etc.
4. Missionaries and ministries, at home and abroad, and to those to whom they minister.

Food Distribution: Come to front door... (check during inclement weather & school closings)

Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:30am to 11am

Tuesday from 8:30am to 3pm
