General Information

Eligibility

To be eligible to participate, you must be 50 years of age or better on or before December 31, 2026 and be a resident of Davie County 3 or more consecutive months of the year.

Age Categories

A participant's age on December 31, 2026 determines the age category in which they will compete. Men and women compete in separate categories in five-year age increments: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+.

Out of County Exceptions

- If an individual from a neighboring county wishes to participate in an event that is not offered in their county, but is offered in Davie County, they may compete in that event at our Local Games. Their scores will be submitted to their local coordinator so they can represent their county during State Finals.
- An individual from a neighboring county may play as a partner in a doubles or mixed doubles sport as long as one of the partners is a resident of Davie County.
- An individual from a neighboring county may play on a team from Davie County as long as half of the team members are Davie County residents. This includes basketball, softball, and performing arts.

Fees

Fees are not refundable nor transferable among participants.

This program is sanctioned by North Carolina Senior Games, Inc. NCSG, Inc. is sponsored statewide by the North Carolina Division of Aging and Adult Services.

Awards

Official gold, silver, and bronze medals will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place men and women's finalist in each category of Senior Games and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd ribbons will be awarded for SilverArts events.

State Finals

- All participants who complete their local games Basketball Shoot, Football Throw, Softball Throw, and Fun Walk events will qualify to participate in those events at State Finals.
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in Heritage and Visual Arts, 1st and 2nd place winners in Literary Arts, 1 representative in Performing Arts and 1 representative in Cheerleading are eligible for State Finals.
- Golfers need to meet a minimum performance score (MPS) and finish in the top 3 in their age group to qualify for State Finals.
- For all other sporting events, you must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd to participate in State Finals. If participants choose to go to State Finals, they are responsible for completing the proper paperwork as well as their own registration, accommodations, and transportation.

Piedmont Senior Champions Tour

The top six scorers in Cornhole, Mini Golf, and Pickleball will be invited to represent Davie County in the 2026 Piedmont Senior Champions Tour. This special competition is held in partnership with Piedmont Plus Senior Games and Yadkin Valley Senior Games. Invitations will be decided by top scores from men and women at our Local Games.

- I waive and release any and all rights, liabilities, and claims against Davie County Senior Games, Davie County Senior Services, the County of Davie and all its coordinating agencies, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, sponsors, any person(s) connected with the event, if any damages occur to my artwork.
- I am responsible for picking up my entry/entries **on April 24 at the Davie County Public Library between 9am -11am unless I win first place. First place entries are responsible for picking up their entry/entries on May 21 at the Senior Games Closing Ceremony.** If I fail to claim my artwork, I will not hold Davie County Senior Games responsible for its safe keeping.
- Regarding performing arts entries in the Davie County SilverArts, my entry will be judged at the local level, and may or may not qualify for North Carolina State Finals (depending on judge's scoring).

To promote total health and physical fitness, events of longer duration and lower intensity are strongly recommended. High-intensity types of activities are offered primarily for the conditioned, trained athlete.

Specific Category Requirements for SilverArts

A. Heritage Arts

- Entries must be the work of the individual and not a group.
- Heritage Art entries must be an original work. Patterns may be used, but no stamped pieces will be accepted.
- Pottery must be hand built or thrown.
- Entries from ceramic molds will not be accepted.
- All framed entries must be securely wired, ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Two-dimensional work not properly framed and wired will not be displayed.
- Framed entries can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- All entries, except framed work, must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 4'(Height).
- Groupings (sets) shall have no more than 3 separate pieces per set. All objects within each piece of the set must be contained within or attached to one of the 3 pieces of the set.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
- Artist must send a photo of entry with State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times.
- The heritage arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

B. VISUAL ARTS

- All artwork, except free standing pieces, must be framed (or gallery wrapped), securely wired, and ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Artwork, except sculpture, not properly wired will not be displayed.
- Artwork, except free standing pieces, can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- Free standing pieces may be Sculpture, Mixed Media, and Digital Art.
- Freestanding entries must be able to be displayed in an area 3' (W) x 3' (L) x 4' (height)
- Photography film or digital - determined by the medium on which the image is recorded.
- Freestanding entries must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3' (L) x 4' (height).
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times.
- If on-site assembly is required, details must be specified on the Information Form for NCSG prior approval.
- The art piece must be an original work, not a print.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
- Artist must send a photograph of entry with State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
- The visual arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

C. Literary Arts

- All Essay, Life Experience, and Short Story entries must be typed, double-spaced on 8-1/2 x 11 paper, and have a minimum of 1" margins. A minimum font size is 10-pt type (preferably "times new roman or arial"). Essays, Life

- Experiences, and Short Stories can be no longer than 8 pages.
 - Poetry entries must be typed, on 8-1/2 x 11 paper, and have a minimum of 1" margins, but double spacing is not required. (Appearance must support and contribute to the meaning of the poem and its impact.) A minimum font size is 10-pt type (preferably "times new roman or Arial"). Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
 - All entries must have a title page, which includes title of entry, sub-category, and name of artist.
 - Artist's name must not appear on the content pages.
 - A display-quality copy of the winning Literary Arts entries, and two (2) additional copies, should be submitted to NCSG by the artist with their official State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. No framed or matted entries will be accepted. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
 - The original and all copies will be retained by NCSG. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
 - The literary arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
 - An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.
- ## D. PERFORMING ARTS
- An artist may only have one (1) entry per size of act in each subcategory.
 - Performing entries are limited to three (3) minutes of on-stage time. Exceeding the time limit will result in automatic disqualification. Timing is the performer's responsibility and begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the final note of music or movement of the act.
 - Performing entries may be one of the following: (a) soloists, (b) small groups (2 - 4 performers), or (c) large groups (5 or more performers). Accompanist(s) will be counted to determine size of act. No one under age 50 as of Dec. 31st will be permitted on stage and an accompanist must be a registered participant.
 - All performers for all acts must enter stage left and exit stage left or begin and end on the stage. See the SilverArts Manual for a stage diagram. **(FOR STATE FINALS ONLY)**
 - At State Finals, any recorded music must be an mp3 file (submitted electronically or on a flash drive, CD's cannot be accepted). Music must be submitted with the online registration or sent with the State Finals Entry Form. No recorded instruction is permitted. This should be the only track on the flash drive or electronic file. Music may be picked up following the performance. It cannot be mailed/returned.
 - At State Finals, NCSG can provide the following items: chairs, microphone(s) piano, and sound system. The act is responsible for all other props and equipment and must get NCSG advance approval for us at show. Props must be small, few, light-weight, and easy to set up quickly.
 - Voice presentations must be a live performance by the artist. Background music can be recorded. Lip-synch is not permitted in any vocal category.
 - The Group Leader, who must be a participant, must complete the SilverArts Information Form for the group and submit it with their State Finals Entry Form and each member of the group must submit their own personal State Finals Entry Form by the August 1st deadline.
 - The performance at State Finals must be the same performance that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.
 - No live animals are allowed, except for service animals.
