



Requirements for Residential Electrical Reconnection **(Power Disconnected Over 6 Months)**

Reconnection of electrical service will be denied if any of the following items are deemed true by the inspector:

1. Foundation appears to be structurally unsound.
2. Visible holes or leaks in the exterior walls.
3. Visible holes or leaks in the roof.
4. Missing or leaking windows.
5. Required means of egress not in compliance with the current version of the building code.

Reconnection of electrical service may also be denied if the inspector deems the structure to be a hazard to life safety, for reasons other than stated above.

An Electrical Reconnection Permit is not a construction permit. If it is deemed by the inspector that repairs need to be made, an electrical permit will be required for the repairs.
