

Davie County Recycling Options



Solid Waste Disposal and Transfer Station

Davie County does not operate a landfill, but instead has contracted with Republic Services to operate a site at the old landfill location for the convenience of Davie County residents. Residents who are not current Republic Services customers, may utilize the disposal site at their convenience and the following disposal rates are applicable:

- \$10 for a car load or pick-up truck load
- \$25 for a trailer load
- \$35 for a pick-up and trailer load
- Recyclables and metals are accepted free of charge and no fee will be incurred for the disposal of these items.
- The facility no longer accepts yard waste. This type of waste should be directed to Wallace Farm located on 162 acres on Lee Jackson Drive in Advance.

Green/Yard Waste Collection



The Davie County Department of Public Utilities is pleased to offer **yard waste collection** through a partnership with Wallace Farm, 270 Lee Jackson Dr., Advance. Wallace Farm provides a wide-range of agricultural services, but will now offer their facility as a location where **yard waste** can be accepted and then processed and converted into a number of green, reusable products.

Electronics Recycling



Davie County offers residents the opportunity to dispose of unused electronics. Collection is handled at the Dalton Road collection site and run from **8 a.m. until noon** on the **last Saturday of the first month of each quarter**.

Hazardous Waste Collection



Davie County does not currently have a hazardous waste collection program. Examples of hazardous waste include paint, pesticides, petroleum derivatives, such as motor oil and solvents, and explosive items. Davie County partners with Davie Cooperative Extension and NC Department of Agriculture & Consumer Sciences to offer a collection of unused/unwanted pesticides in original containers. Residents are encouraged to **contact the Davie County office of Cooperative Extension** to be directed to entities that offer private hazardous waste recycling programs (for example, cell phone disposal, paint disposal, lightbulb disposal, etc.) In addition, residents can visit the 3RC EnviroStation in Forsyth County to dispose of household hazardous waste. There is a charge for disposal by non-county residents and is based on the weight of the item. For example, paint is \$.75/lb and antifreeze is \$.40/lb.
