## DAVIE COUNTY RECREATION AND PARKS RECEIVES DAVIE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT AWARD

The Davie County Recreation and Parks Department is pleased to announce that it has received a \$40,000 grant from the Davie Community Foundation. The grant will help secure the installation of two (2) competition bocce ball courts, two (2) competition horseshoe pits and courtyard seating within the alumni plaza areas of the new park master plan. The grant allows the County and Project Team professionals to include these two (2) amenities in conjunction with Phase I construction of the Davie County High School Repurposing Project.

"This award was a major victory for our community," said Paul Moore, Director of Recreation and Parks for the County of Davie. "While this funding will benefit all of our citizens, it will particularly assist and provide access to those with disabilities who participate in Special Olympic programming and our Active Older Adults who participate in Senior Games activities in Davie County."

In addition, these amenities will provide a safe and healthy place to play and compete; foster community; enrich active movement by offering multiple programming opportunities; provide educational workshops that promote physical activity; social comradeship and health benefits while improving the Quality of Life for the people of Davie County.

"The Davie County Recreation and Parks department believes that parks and exceptional recreation experiences are vital to achieving high Quality of Life for current and future generations to come. On behalf of the County of Davie, we are grateful to the Davie Community Foundation; the leadership facilitating the Health Davie Initiative, and its generosity to our community and new County Park."

Phase I construction of the new County Park is scheduled to begin in Fall 2018 with projected completion in Summer 2019.
