



## **Certificate of Compliance (CC)**

A Certificate of Compliance is required by the North Carolina General Statutes to represent that the scope of work, as described in the permit documents, is complete (final). At the conclusion of all completed work done under a permit, including all applicable Building, Electrical, Mechanical, Plumbing or the Fire Code regulations, the Code Enforcement Official will final that particular permit. The contractor/customer will be able to request a Certificate of Compliance (CC) via the online permitting system:

A Certificate of Compliance does NOT grant occupancy. No new building or part thereof may be occupied, no addition or enlargement of an existing building may be occupied, and no existing building that has been altered may be occupied until a Code Enforcement Official has issued a Certificate of Occupancy (CO). Violation of this section constitutes a misdemeanor under the NC GS 153A-363 and NC GS 160A-423.

## **Certificate of Occupancy (CO)**

At the conclusion of all completed work done under a permit, including all applicable Building, Electrical, Mechanical, Plumbing or Fire Code regulations, the Code Enforcement Official will final that particular permit. When all permits related to a project have been marked as final and all fire codes, state and local laws, local ordinances and regulations have been satisfied (and the agency responsible for enforcing the local ordinance or regulations has released its holds on the project), Code Enforcement Officials will issue a Certificate of Occupancy (CO).

No new building or part thereof may be occupied, no addition or enlargement of an existing building may be occupied, and no existing building that has been altered may be occupied until a Code Enforcement Official has issued a Certificate of Occupancy (CO). Violation of this section constitutes a misdemeanor under the NC GS 153A-363 and NC GS 160A-423.
