Section 31.001. PUPRPOSE

The purpose of this Chapter shall be to insure the proper organization of county government into a county-manager plan under NC.G.S. 153A-76 and N.C.G.S. 153A-81 for the promotion of orderly and efficient administration of county affairs.

Section 31.002. APPLICABILITY

The Board of Commissioners hereby adopt the county-manager plan of government (also sometimes referred to as the council-manager or commission-manager form of government) for Davie County, North Carolina pursuant to N.C.G.S. 153A-81 and delegates to the county manager powers and duties otherwise granted to the Board of County Commissioners, (including but not limited to the retaining of outside counsel), except as to those powers and duties not otherwise authorized to be delegated by general statute.

Section 31.003. ROLE OF COUNTY MANAGER

The County Manager shall be the chief administrator of county government. He shall be responsible to the Board of Commissioners for the administration of all departments of county government under the board's general control and shall have all powers and duties as outlined in N.C.G.S. 153A-82, and shall further have the authority to exercise the corporate authority which can be exercised by the Board of Commissioners by general statute, except as to those powers and duties not otherwise authorized to be delegated by general statute.
