Contingency Plan Update 4.9.2020

Good Afternoon,

As of today, April 9, 2020, Davie County Recreation and Parks has an approved updated contingency plan for the safety of our community as it relates to COVID-19. Please note that your DCRP team is continually keeping up with the newest developments of the COVID-19 pandemic. We will let those developments determine how we will continue to respond, so all information below is subject to change.

After recommendations made by our state officials, Davie County Government, and Davie County Recreation and Parks our team will employ the following actions as preemptive measures effective immediately:

General Programming

- Open Gym – cancelled until further notice.
- Pickleball – cancelled until further notice.
- Martial Arts – postponed until June 1. (Subject to change.)
- Dance/Tumbling Session 3 – cancelled.

Athletic Programs

- Youth Volleyball League 2020 - cancelled. A refund will be issued – an email to all registrants will follow with more details.
- Adult Basketball Church League (already started) - cancelled. A refund will be issued – an email will follow to team captains with more details.
- Try LAX (already started) - postponed until further notice. We plan on continuing this program once we can resume safely.
- DC LAX League (already started) – Per PCLA, practices and games are postponed will the league continuing once we can resume safely.
- Adult Softball Church League – postponed until further notice. We plan on providing this league once we can do so safely.

Special Events

- DCCP Grand Opening as well as DC AMP Fest are postponed. We will reevaluate our current situation at a later date to determine a reschedule date that best protects the health, safety and integrity of the community.
- Mother Son Game Night is postponed and will be schedules at a later date.
- Both the Summer Concert and Movies in the Park series are also being evaluated, but are not postponed as of this publication.
