

COVID-19 Update for May 1st, 2020



31 Total* lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases in Davie County

*This is a cumulative total of lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases for Davie County, which means this will not be reduced as a result of deaths or people being released from isolation.

24 patients meet the requirements to be released from isolation (7 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared, 3 days have passed since resolution of fever without use of fever-reducing medications, and show improvement in respiratory symptoms).

- Two of the 24 have received follow-up tests with negative results for COVID-19.

5 cases are currently sick:

- One of the 5 cases was confirmed today, May 1st, 2020.

+ 2 patients with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 are deceased.

Of the 31 cases of lab-confirmed COVID-19 in Davie County, 10 of the individuals are 65 years of age or older, 10 are 50-64 years of age, 7 are 25-49 years of age, two are 18-24 years of age, and two are 17 years of age or younger.
